1. Chairman's welcome and apologies for absence

Apologies were received from Stuart Clancy, John Starling, Joanne Keeler, John Self and Graham Buckley

2 Declarations of Interest

None raised

3 To Ratify the Minutes of the Meeting held on 4 June 2013

The minutes were signed as being a true record of the meeting.

4 Matters arising from the Minutes of the Meetings on 4 June 2013

4.1 4.1 A quote had been received for trimming the hedge at 4 Taverham Road, which was £60-8- including clearance. Councillors AGREED to accept the quote.

4.2 11.2 – public right of way grass cutting. Highways had advised that there were no refunds or funding available for this. Highways would only arrange to cut a path if it was not “reasonably passable”.

5 Police Report

5.1 During June 2113 12 calls were made to the control room, with one crime being logged (theft from motor vehicle).

6 Reports from County & District Councillors

No district or county councillors were present.

8 Correspondence

8.1 The Norfolk and Suffolk Local Transport Body: Long List was considered and noted. The clerk would request that Taverham Road be added to the long list with a request to make it one way or apply the weight limit both ways.

8.2 Public Transport Scrutiny Review - considered and noted. No comments to make.

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8.3 Felthorpe Cricket Club – a thank you letter had been received for the donation towards the clubs grass cutting costs.

8.4 A letter had been received from Keith Simpson MP who would like to attend a Parish Council meeting. The clerk would contact him with the dates of the monthly meetings.

8.5 Dog bin installation. A quote had been received for £40 to install the bin and supply the fixings.
This price was AGREED by councilors. The clerk would meet with a Pavilion representative to establish where to locate the bin.

9 Planning

11.4 Cllr Clarke reported that visibility was impaired on The Street due to an overgrown

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hedge at no. 65 , which heavy good vehicles were having to drive out into the middle of the road to avoid. The clerk would write to the residents regarding this.
